Bill Mosena called the meeting to order. Stacy Marshall welcomed everyone and thanked the owners of TJ's Night Life for their willingness to allow the RSC to meet at their business. Stacy then addressed meeting/exceeding the goals set for 2010, including membership and charity involvement/donations. Stacy asked Judy Inscore for changes in board meeting minutes from the October meeting. Judy stated there were no changes. Karen Brown made motion to accept the minutes and it was seconded.

Margaret Griffin reported a balance of \$6,661.79 as of 9/30/10. October deposits were \$7,115.14, which included interest of \$.14. Disbursements for October totaled \$1,133.61, leaving a balance of \$12,643.32 as of 10/31/10. There is an outstanding check dated 10/22/10 for \$540.00. When that check is deleted from our account, in addition to checks written since 10-31-10, totaling \$8,144.32 and deposits of \$207.00, our balance as of 11-12-10 is \$4,166.00. We have petty cash of \$91.20 as \$8.80 was spent on stamps. This report, along with bills/receipts, will be filed for year-end audit.

Warren Grant said this year has been an exciting/successful year and he wants to move forward, asking all members to make next year even better. Lee Smith reported 329 members.

Jackie Inscore asked Tricia and Erich Kolb and Debra Fearing to come forward and be recognized for their contribution to PIPF in honor of Tricia's mother Debra and in memory of Erich's mother. Stacy presented a check to Bernadette Pickles, representing the PIPF, for \$11,850 as the grand total raised at the PIPF event on Oct. 16. Bernadette then thanked everyone for their participation and efforts toward this wonderful cause. A RSC group picture was taken, with Bernadette included, to be sent to the News and Observer. Jackie then discussed the Christmas Party on Dec. 11, with doors opening at 6:30, a prime rib dinner served from 7-8:30, Jimmy Pearce playing music 6:30-8 and Roy Childress playing from 8-12. Reservations are requested prior to Dec. 1. Tickets are \$10 for members and \$15 for guests. This ticket includes a reverse raffle ticket for cash.

Tommy Smith stated that additional raffle tickets will be sold that night for \$5. Tommy also stated that 50/50 tickets are being sold at tonight's meeting.

Stacy thanked those that were preparing tonight's meal. He then asked the nominating committee to come forward – Emma Vance and Tom Jones (Jim Adcox was absent). They presented the following slate of officers for 2011: President – Stacy Marshall, Vice President – Warren Grant, Secretary – Patty Battle, Treasurer – Margaret Griffin and Sgt. At Arms – Bill Mears. They then opened the floor for nominations; none were submitted. Karen Brown made a motion to accept the presented slate; it was seconded and voted unanimous. Margaret Griffin has SOS cards for sale. The Hospice Cabin Fever Throwdown is scheduled for Feb. 27. Stacy presented the Nov. birthdays. Earl Fowler asked the blessing. Judy Inscore made a motion to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded.
