Bill Mosen called the meeting to order. Stacy Marshall welcomed everyone and thanked the owners of TJ's Night Life for their hospitality and generosity on giving the RSC an outstanding place to meet. Stacy asked Judy Inscore for changes in board meeting minutes from the September meeting. Judy stated no changes; Karen Brown made a motion to accept the minutes and it was seconded. Judy then read a note of thanks from the Barnhill family for the Hospice contribution in memory of Mr. Barnhill.

In Margaret Griffin's absence, Judy Inscore gave the Treasurer's report; a balance of \$4,507.90 as of 8-31-10, which includes interest of \$.08. Deposits were \$3,899.43, disbursements were \$1,745.54, leaving a balance as of 9-30-10 of \$6,661.79, with one outstanding check in the amount of \$53.96. However, approximately \$2,900.00 of that final balance is earmarked for our Pretty in Pink Foundation benefit. We have \$91.20 in petty cash. This report, along with bills/receipts will be filed for year-end audit.

Warren Grant asked for a show of hands for those who will be attending the PIPF event on Oct. 16. He asked for participation in all areas. He then mentioned the Christmas Party but will wait for the social chair to cover this. Stacy spoke on behalf of Lee Smith, stating we now have 318 members.

Jackie Inscore said that the Shooter Party was a great success; there were 148 attendees of which, 100 were RSC members. We gained six new members from this also. Jackie discussed the details of the upcoming Christmas Party, including menu, dj, etc. Jackie then covered the details of the PIPF event, asking everyone to participate, volunteer, buy tickets, etc. He also updated the ticket/table sales, saying that if an individual wanted to buy 1 ticket and get a seat, then this person would be assigned to a table and any additional single ticket sales would be added to the table until it was filled. Jackie then thanked Don Bunn for teaching free shag lessons to the PIPF staff/champions/volunteers.

Tommy Smith asked for volunteers for PIPF and particularly, for selling tickets. Pettis Montague said that everyone should look forward to the delicious meal that will be served Saturday at the event.

Stacy said that he appointed a nominating committee comprised of Tom Jones, Emma Vance and Jim Adcox to present a slate of RSC officers at the upcoming November monthly meeting.

Stacy then read the October birthdays and asked the members to come forward to get beads to wear in order to designate the honorees for the birthday dance. Tom Jones asked the blessing for the meal. Tommy Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded.
