Jackie reviewed details of the PIPF event on Oct. 16. He said Don Bunn has graciously agreed to give free shag lessons to the PIPF staff/champions on Oct. 3&10 from 3-4:30 at TJs Night Life. Jackie reminded everyone of the PIPF Hike for Hope on Saturday, Sept. 18 at Bond Park in Cary and asked if anyone wanted to dance, to let him know tonight as the names had to be turned in.

Tommy Smith recognized Gray Pike for his hard work in chairing the golf tournament in June. Warren presented P.J. Smith, who sponsors a golf tournament in Myrtle Beach. She said that the money collected this year will go to PIPF.
